

## Term 2 Senior Examinations

Wednesday 18 May – Friday 20 May (Inclusive)

- **Students from Years 12 and 13 need only be at school to sit examinations; otherwise they are on study leave.**
- **All Year 11 students will have classes as normal on *Wednesday 18 May*. Those Year 11 students who will be sitting the NCEA English exam will begin this exam at 2.00pm on Wednesday afternoon. For Thursday and Friday, Year 11 will be on study leave unless sitting exams.**
- **A supervised study room (C09) will be available at all times.**
- **The timetable is available on the web page.**
- **During the exams, both senior and junior classes will operate within the exam times as set out below**

- 
1. Examinations times are as follows: 9.00am – 11.00am, 11.30am - 12.30pm, 1.00am – 3.00pm
  2. Students must be at the examination venue **20 minutes prior** to the start of the examination so they can be seated.
  3. Students must line up in their classes outside the Student Services Side entrance (Pizza Hutt if wet).
  4. Latecomers may be denied entry to the examination until the Supervisor can arrange that they do not disturb other students.
  5. All equipment must be in a clear plastic bag.
  6. All other bags and equipment must be left at the front of the examination room.
  7. NO Cellphones, cameras, ipods, MP3 Players.
  8. Calculators need to be checked prior to each examination.
  9. Bring a book in case you finish early. Generally students will not be allowed to leave early unless it is one hour prior to the end of a 2 hour examination.
  10. All students must wear correct school uniform.
  11. As with the NCEA examinations, you may need to make alternative transport arrangements to get to and from the examinations.
  12. **C09 will be the supervised study room during the examinations – there must be total silence. Students are not permitted to wander around the school or throw balls in the quad when exams are on and Juniors have normal classes.**

Once in the Examination:

1. Candidates must be silent and not communicate in any way with any other candidate.
2. Students may only leave 1 hour before the end of the examination if they are in a 2 hour examination. Otherwise they must stay in class the entire time.
3. Answers must be in black or blue ink, no pencil.
